



BURNOUT ALLEY RULES AND REGULATIONS
All patrons will be expected to abide by the following policies:

- Camping is permitted within designated spots only. **Persons entering Burn Out Alley do so at their own risk.**
- **DURING EVENT TIME ONLY:** Feel free to stop by the Concierge with any questions you may have throughout the weekend. The Concierge staff will be available during specific hours that will be communicated by the Corporate Sales department prior to the race weekend. The phone number during race weekend to reach the Concierge staff is (817) 255-6057.
- ALL spots will be pumped several times throughout the race weekend. Contact the Corporate Sales department to find out times each race weekend. Be sure to have your compartments unlocked and open prior to scheduled pump times.
- No outside catering allowed on Speedway property. All catering must be coordinated through Levy Restaurants Sports & Entertainment (817) 215-8437.
- Please remember that once gates open on Sunday race day, no one will be allowed to pull out of their Burnout Alley space until two hours after the checkered flag.
- Access to Burnout Alley will be restricted to vehicles displaying appropriate event tag, sticker or digital credential. Each designated spot is allowed **ONE** RV/Camper and **ONE** tow vehicle. Both vehicles must be parked **WITHIN** your fenced area.
- Additional vehicle parking is available outside of Gates 9, 10, 11 and is assigned to your individual spot. Each RV space has 3 reserved parking spaces outside of the gates. Overflow parking is available across the inner-ring road (Lone Star Circle) at the Dirt Track.
- Vehicles cannot exceed 13'6" in height within your assigned space.
- All banners/signs must be hung on the interior of the black vinyl fencing and must face **INWARD**.
- Open flame or open pit campfires are prohibited anywhere on Speedway property.
- Charcoal and gas grills are allowed in Burnout Alley *except during practice sessions, qualifying or during a race*. All BBQ grills must be at least 10 feet away from combustibles – cars, campers, tents, awnings, etc.
- No storage of gasoline is permitted in Burnout Alley.
- All pets on Speedway property must be kept on a leash while outside personal vehicle. For the comfort of others visiting our property – please clean up after your pet.
- Confederate flags (including flags, signs and banners that contain the Confederate flag) are not allowed. Speedway management reserves the right to remove any and all banners, signs or flags not in compliance with this policy or which, in their sole judgement, violates this policy. If you refuse to allow the removal of any such banner, sign or flag, you will be subject to removal from Speedway premises.
- All banners, signs and flags openly displayed (included but not limited to on vehicles, clothing, hats or other accessory items) while on the premises of Texas Motor Speedway must comply with this policy. Banners, signs or flags should contain no obscene language, symbols or logos, or graphic depictions. Speedway management reserves the right to approve all banners, signs and flags.
- One golf cart per space is allowed in Burnout Alley with proper insurance coverage. Rental and credential applications will be emailed prior to each race weekend.
- No ATVs or personal golf carts will be allowed in Burnout Alley. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- No Swimming Pools or Hot Tubs allowed.
- No Stages, Stage Lights, Live Bands or Live DJ's .
- Do not park RV's in fire lanes or within 15' feet of fire hydrants. Hydrants must be accessible to emergency vehicles. No parking is allowed outside of the fenced spots in Burnout Alley.
- All persons must conduct themselves with due regard for their health and safety, and that of fellow campers, and obey all laws. TMS is not liable for actions which endanger your safety or others. Watch your property, TMS is not liable for lost or stolen items.
- No box trucks will be allowed in Burnout Alley.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO** cruising will be permitted in any of the camping areas.
- **NO** lewd conduct will be allowed on Speedway property.
- A noise curfew of 1 a.m. will be enforced in **ALL** campgrounds. (Does not include generators)
- The operation or flying of any unmanned aircraft, drone, or remote-controlled aircraft is **NOT** allowed on TMS property. **All such aircraft will be confiscated.**
- **All camping areas will be patrolled by Speedway security staff and City Police Officers; enforcing a NO TOLERANCE policy on ALL campground policies.**

REMINDER: Anyone operating unapproved unlicensed motorized vehicles (ATV'S, golf carts, two-wheeled vehicles, etc.), will be asked to immediately take them off property and not be allowed to return.
